

We were able to collect data on the following industries: Hotel, Catering, Large Venue, Assisted Living, Food Service, Fulfillment/Distribution, Manufacturing, and Retail.

Highest and lowest wages

Average Hourly Wages range between \$14.00 and \$17.89, with the lowest wages being paid in Retail, and the highest being paid in the Catering industry.

Average and median differences

Average and Median Hourly Wages were close in most of the industries except for Hotels, Catering and Food Service, which means one or more job types in these industries are paid disproportionately to the sector as a whole.



We were able to collect data on the following job types: Busser, Food Service, Sever or Banquet Server, Bartender, Dishwasher or Kitchen Steward, Full Service Bartender, Line or Prep Cook, Sanitation, Cashier, Concessions, and Housekeeper.

Highest and lowest wages

Average Hourly Wages ranged between \$13.58 being paid to Housekeepers and \$18.08 paid to Bussers.

Average and Median differences

Average Hourly Wages and Median Hourly Wages were close in all job types except for Concessions Staff. With the average being significantly higher than the median it means that one or more employers offered wages notably higher than the market conditions.




Highest and lowest wages


Average Hourly Wages ranged between \$13.06 being paid to Packers and \$16.99 paid to Assemblers.

Average and median differences

Average Hourly Wages and Median Hourly Wages were close in all job types except for Bindery Associates, which means employers are matching market wages closely most of the time.

Cincinnati - conclusions

After reviewing the Industry and Job Type Average and Median Hourly Wages, we can conclude the following for the Cincinnati, OH market in Q1 2022:

- The industry with the **highest hourly wages is Hotels**, with Median Hourly Wages sitting at \$18.00.
- The industry with the **lowest hourly wages is Retail**, with Median Hourly Wages sitting at \$14.
- The **highest-paid job** in the market is Busser, with \$18.00 median being paid for an hour of work.
- The lowest-paid job in the market is Packer, with a \$13.00/hr median wage.


Hospitality and F&B industries were slightly higher paid than their Light industrial counterparts, with an average \$16.63 hourly wage in Hospitality, and \$15.11 in the Light Industrial sector.

We were able to collect data on the following industries: Catering, Food Service, Large Venue, Janitorial, Assisted Living, Fulfillment and Distribution, Hotel, Retail, and Manufacturing.

Highest and lowest wages

Average Hourly Wages range between \$15.00 and \$19.85, with the lowest wages being paid in Manufacturing, and the highest being paid in Catering.

Average and median differences

Average Hourly Wages and Median Hourly Wages were close in all job types except for Food Service, in which case a rather large discrepancy is due to one or more job types being paid significantly higher than the sector average.



We were able to collect data on the following job types: Bartender, Dishwasher or Kitchen Steward, Barista, Cashier, Full Service Bartender, Line or Prep Cook, Sanitation, Server or Banquet Server, Event Set-Up/Houseman, Busser, Concessions worker, Merchandiser, and Housekeeper.

Highest and lowest wages

Average Hourly Wages ranged between \$15.00 being paid to Housekeepers and \$20.00 paid to Bartenders.

Average and Median differences

Average and Median Hourly Wages were varying in Barista, Line Cook/Prep Cook, Sanitation, and Event Set-Up/Houseman positions, which means one or more employers are assigning the wages significantly disproportionately to the sector as a whole.



We were able to collect data on the following job types: Receiving Clerk, Warehouse Associate, Assembler, Packer, Picker, and Utility.

Highest and lowest wages

Average Hourly Wages ranged between \$15.00 being paid to Utility workers and \$19.11 paid to Receiving Clerks.

Average and median differences

Average Hourly Wages and Median Hourly Wages were close in all job types except for Receiving Clerks. With the average being significantly higher than the median it means that one or more employers offered wages notably higher than the market conditions.

Columbus - conclusions

After reviewing the Industry and Job Type Average and Median Hourly Wages, we can conclude the following for the Columbus, OH market in Q1 2022:

- The industry with the **highest hourly wages is Catering**, with Median Hourly Wages sitting at \$20.00.
- The industry with the **lowest hourly wages is Manufacturing**, with Median Hourly Wages sitting at \$15.
- The **highest-paid job** in the market is Bartender, with a \$20 median being paid for an hour of work
- The **lowest-paid jobs** in the market are Housekeeping and Warehouse Utility, with a \$15/hr median wage.


Hospitality and F&B industries were slightly higher paid than their Light industrial counterparts, with the average hourly wage being \$17.33 in Hospitality, and \$16.56 in Light Industrial sectors.

We were able to collect data on the following industries: Hotel, Catering, Food Service, Fulfillment and Distribution, Large Venue, and Retail.

Highest and lowest wages

Average Hourly Wages range between \$14.10 and \$16.67, with the lowest wages being paid in Retail, and the highest being paid in the Hotel industry.

Average and median differences

Average Hourly Wages and Median Hourly Wages were close in most of the industries except for Hotels and Catering, in which certain positions were paid either significantly lower or higher than the sector benchmark.



We were able to collect data on the following job types: Barback/Busser, Brand Ambassador, Line or Prep Cook, Server or Banquet Server, Concessions Worker, Barista, Event Set-Up/Houseman, Cashier, Busser, Dishwasher/Kitchen Steward, Housekeeper, Sanitation, and Merchandiser.

Highest and lowest wages

Average Hourly Wages ranged between \$13.50 being paid to Merchandisers and \$18.77 paid to Barbacks/Bussers.

Average and Median differences

Average Hourly Wages and Median Hourly Wages were close in all job types except for Barbacks/Bussers and Event Set-Up/Housemen. With the average being higher than the median it means, that one or more employers paid wages significantly higher than the market benchmark for the respective positions.



Average and median differences

Average Hourly Wages and Median Hourly Wages were close in all job types which means employers are matching market wages closely.

Cleveland - conclusions

After reviewing the Industry and Job Type Average and Median Hourly Wages, we can conclude the following for the Cleveland, OH market in Q1 2022:

- The industry with the **highest hourly wages is Hotel**, with Median Hourly Wages sitting at \$18.
- The industry with the **lowest hourly wages is Retail**, with Median Hourly Wages sitting at \$14
- The **highest-paid job** in the market is Barback/Busser, with \$18.00 dollar median being paid for an hour of work.
- The **lowest-paid job** in the market is Merchandiser, with a \$13.50/hr median wage.

Hospitality and F&B industries were slightly higher paid than their Light industrial counterparts, with the average hourly wage being \$15.88 in Hospitality and \$14.69 in the Light Industrial sector.



Summary

The best paid jobs in Q1 2022 were in the Hospitality and F&B sectors, with Bartender, Busser/Barback, and Server/Banquet Server being the highest-paid positions across the Ohio labor market. The median hourly wage for the Hospitality industry is \$16.74.

On average, Light Industrial jobs were paid \$1.22 less per hour than Hospitality jobs, with the average hourly wage sitting at \$15.45 across the sector.

Columbus labor market was by far the most expensive in terms of an average hourly wage, with \$17.03 per hour of work. Cleveland has been placed second, with an average hour of work costing \$16.09, and Cincinnati last, with hourly worker wage sitting at \$15.83 per hour.

Average Hourly Wage and Median Hourly Wage were very similar across all job types, with a few exceptions noted in their respective chapters. What these exceptions indicate is that certain positions are either highly overpaid or underpaid due to either lack of information or other differentiating factors.

What we hope to achieve with this report is to **help employers make informed and accurate decisions** on setting wages for hiring workers.
