With more transparency on the current market rates, offering **competitive wages and accurate data** is one of the best ways to make sure you can attract enough job candidates.








Overview of industries

Industries we collected data for

We were able to collect data on the following industries: Catering, Clubs, Education, Large Venue, Food Service, Fulfillment & Distribution, Hotel, and Manufacturing.

Highest and lowest wages

Average Hourly Wages range between \$13.00 and \$22.12, with the lowest wages being paid in the Manufacturing sector and the highest wages in Catering.

Average and median differences

Average Hourly Wages and Median Hourly Wages were close in most of the industries except for Catering and Large Venue, in which certain positions were paid either significantly lower or higher than the sector benchmark.



Positions we collected data for

We were able to collect data on a wide array of positions, with Concessions being the lowest paid position with an average of \$15.00 paid per hour of work, and the Sous Chef position being the highest paid, with \$25.00 on average.

Average and Median differences

Average Hourly Wages and Median Hourly Wages were close in all job types except for Full-Service Bartender, where the median was significantly higher, signifying that a big portion of jobs was highly underpaid.

Conclusions

After viewing the Industry and Job Type Average and Median Hourly Wages, we can conclude the following for the Miami, FL market in Q2 2022:

- The industry with the **highest hourly wages** was Catering, with Median Hourly Wages sitting at \$25.
- The industry with the lowest hourly wages is Manufacturing, with Median Hourly Wages sitting at \$13.
- The **highest-paid job** in the market was Sous Chef, with a \$25 median being paid for an hour of work.
- The lowest-paid jobs in the market was Stocker, with a median wage of \$15/hr.

Summary

The best-paid jobs in Q2 2022 were in the Catering and Large Venue sectors, with Sous Chef, Full-Service Bartender, and Server/Banquet Server being the highestpaid positions.

The labor market in Miami, based on our gathered data, was averaging \$18.12 per hour of work, with Sous Chef as a significantly highest-paid position.

Average Hourly Wage and Median Hourly Wage were very similar across all job types but highly disproportionate in Industry breakdown. What these exceptions indicate is that certain job types are either highly overpaid or underpaid due to either lack of information or other differentiating factors.

What we hope to achieve with this report is to help employers make informed and accurate decisions on setting wages for hiring workers.
