

Industries we collected data for

We were able to collect data on the following industries: Retail, Clubs, Education, Catering, Assisted Living, Food Service, Large Venue, and Hotel.

Highest and lowest wages

Average Hourly Wages range between \$15.98 and \$17.31, with the lowest wages being paid in the Hotel sector and the highest wages in Clubs.

Average and median differences

Average Hourly Wages and Median Hourly Wages were close in most of the industries except for Large Venue and Hotel, in which certain positions were paid either significantly lower or higher than the sector benchmark.



Positions we collected data for

We were able to collect data on a wide array of positions, with Housekeeper being the lowest paid position with an average of \$14.31 paid per hour of work, and the Full-Service Bartender position being the highest paid, with \$21.34 on average.

Average and Median differences

Average Hourly Wages and Median Hourly Wages were close in most of the positions except for Full-Service Bartender and Food Service positions. A very high discrepancy between Average and Median Hourly wage signifies, that the position was highly overpaid in at least one case.

Conclusions

After viewing the Industry and Job Type Average and Median Hourly Wages, we can conclude the following for the Atlanta, GA market in Q3 2022:

- The industry with the **highest hourly wages was Clubs**, with Median Hourly Wages sitting at \$17.31.
- The industry with the **lowest hourly wages is Hotel**, with Median Hourly Wages sitting at \$15.
- The **highest-paid job** in the market was Full-Service Bartender, with a \$21.34 dollar average being paid per hour
- The **lowest-paid jobs** in the market were Housekeeper, with a median wage of \$14/hr.

Summary

The best-paid jobs in Q3 2022 were in the Retail, Clubs, and Education sectors, with Full-Service Bartender, Food Service, and Customer service being the highest-paid positions.

Average Hourly Wage and Median Hourly Wage were very similar across all job types but highly disproportionate in Industry breakdown. What these exceptions indicate is that **certain job types are either highly overpaid or underpaid due to either lack of information or other differentiating factors.**

What we hope to achieve with this report is to **help employers make informed and accurate decisions** on setting wages for hiring workers.
